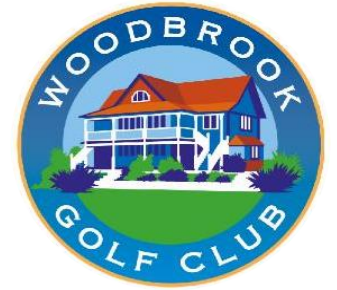
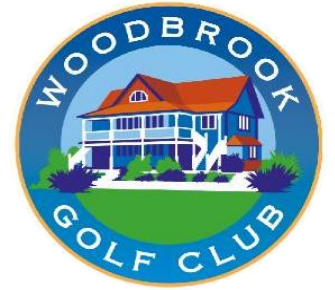


3 Simple Rules



- Treat the golf course with **respect**
 - *A golf course is a living, breathing thing and if you treat the course kindly, it will be kind to you!*
 - *Repair your ball marks on the putting surfaces, smooth and rake your footprints from the sand bunkers, and fill/replace your divots.*
- Observe and follow posted **rules and guidelines**
 - *Check the board and with the Caddymaster*
- Understand that if **stakes and ropes** are present, they are there to prevent you from potentially damaging a sensitive area.
 - *Vary your normal route and go around stakes and ropes, do not step over or on them.*

Pitchmark Repair



- The average number of ball marks made on greens per round is **8** per golfer.
- There are on average **100** rounds of golf played in Woodbrook every day.
- That is **800** impressions **daily**, or **24,000** per **month**, or **288,000** per **year**

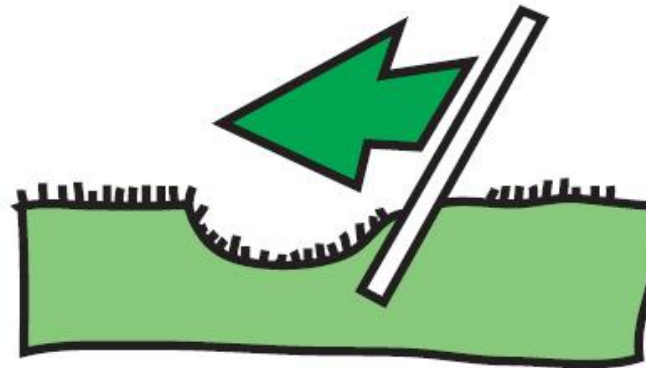

Repair your pitchmarks

Pushing the bottom of the depression upward only tears the roots, and kills the grass.

Right: Using the prongs to push grass at the edge of the depression toward the centre



Wrong: Using the prongs as levers to push up the bottom of the depression
